COURSE AGENDA

The program is tailored to the needs of the participants and focuses on the elaboration of the ISO 31000 framework, adapted (customised) to the participants specific situation and input. It comprises the following elements:

- Implementation of the principles identifying gaps and identifying possible solutions preparing a statement
- Implementation of the framework identifying gaps and identifying possible solutions preparing a risk management plan
- Implementation of the process identifying gaps and identifying possible solutions preparing a risk management implementation plan, including the required education, training and resources needed.

PREREQUISITES

- Knowledge of the ISO 31000 standard:
 - o 2009 and/or 2018 versions. If possible, proven by an appropriate certificate.
- Familiarity with the own organisation:
 - Organisational objectives, values, and convictions (what is important and valuable for the organisation and its essential stakeholders)
 - o Organisational structure, decision making and delegation.
 - Current risk management practices
 - Available resources

EDUCATIONAL APPROACH

This training is based both on theory and the practical examples of the participants, aiming to integrate the personal cases of the participants as examples for this course.

- Lectures are focused on examining the existing situations, analyse the gaps with ISO 31000 and provide solutions for problems encountered.
- Working with the real cases of the students assists certification preparation.
- A limited number of participants is allowed so that all may benefit from the learning and interactions with peers.

EXAM AND CERTIFICATION

Before starting the course, participants will be invited to participate in an on-line theoretical exam (open book) of 20 multiple choice questions on ISO 31000:2018, to get everyone abreast with the latest version of the standard. This exam is part of the certification requirements.

- Knowledge and understanding of the ISO 31000 standard (proven by the open book on-line exam 75% required)
- Creation of an initial ISO 31000 framework and its crucial parts, as listed in the section "Certification Objectives".

TRAINER: Peter Blokland, PhD

Peter Blokland, founder of BYAZ bv, studied at the Royal Military School in Brussels (MSc) and had a career in the Belgian Armed Forces and NATO as a Fighter Pilot (F-16), Instructor (Alpha-Jet and SF260M/D), Commanding Officer (5 Sqn), Staff Officer (Training, Flight Safety and Nuclear Operations) and aviation accidents investigator and prevention specialist.

After his active career, he invested in himself through various training courses as a coach, trainer, and entrepreneur. Peter was, and still is, driven by the question of what makes people, teams and organizations excellent. The insights he gained have been collected in his books:

"Total Respect Management" (2013, Lannoo Campus) and "Safety & Performance" (2017, NOVA Science publishers).

It also led to a doctoral study at TUDelft (Faculty of Technology, Policy and Management) where he completed his PhD research, concluded with a dissertation titled: "Towards Sustainable Safety & Performance in Organisations".

Peter is also an expert for the Belgian National Standardisation Body (NBN) for everything that has to do with ISO 31000 (I262).

ABOUT GNIC®

GNIC[®] is an initiative of an international group of individuals, independent from any interest or pressure group, concerned with the development and usage of high quality, effective and efficient certification services for individuals and legal entities. They operate under the legal entity of a Not For Profit Organisation, according to Belgian Law, named "Global Network for Independent Certification", abbreviated «GNIC». GNIC[®] is the registered brand name.
